Call to Order

At 8:04am, Executive Director and Co-Chair Joy Hawkins from the Governor's Office of Student Achievement called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Commissioner Jacobs asked for a motion to accept the day's agenda. Commissioner Caylee Noggle from the Department of Community Health moved to accept, and Commissioner Judy Fitzgerald from the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities seconded the motion. The Executive Cabinet accepted the agenda unanimously.

Legislation and Governor's Budget Priorities

State Workforce Strategies

David Tanner with the Carl Vinson Institute of Government facilitated a discussion on state workforce strategies. Cabinet members discussed what kinds of activities and projects they're working on to address work challenges, current strategies, and what partnerships they are developing. David Tanner also provided an update on the Georgia Department of Administrative Services state workforce project, which is creating career pathways for jobs in state government.

David Tanner with the Carl Vinson Institute of Government presented an update on the development of a 2Gen Leadership Academy Program for Executive Cabinet agency program directors and mangers.
